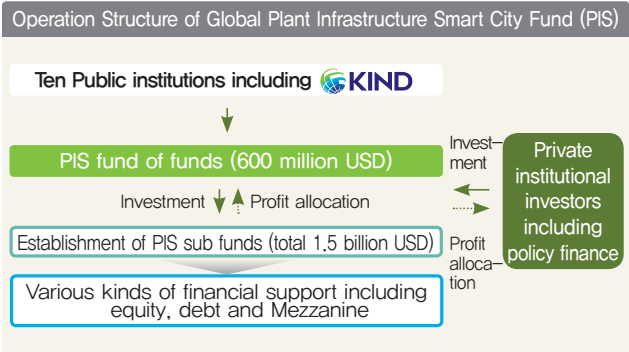

PIS Fund

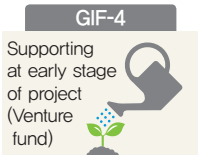
A large-scale fund in the form of a fund of funds created to identify and promote investment in overseas investment and development projects related to overseas plant, infrastructure, and smart city industries



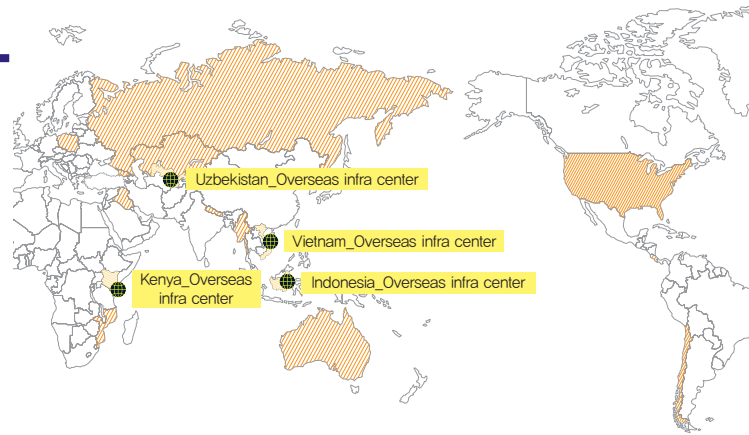
GIF

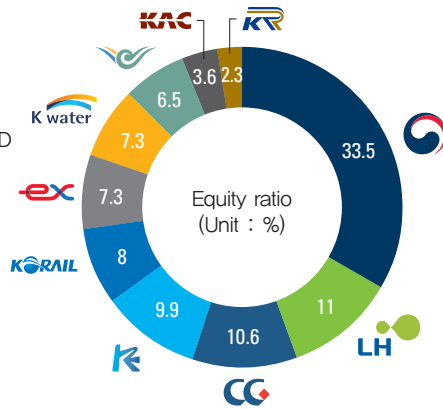

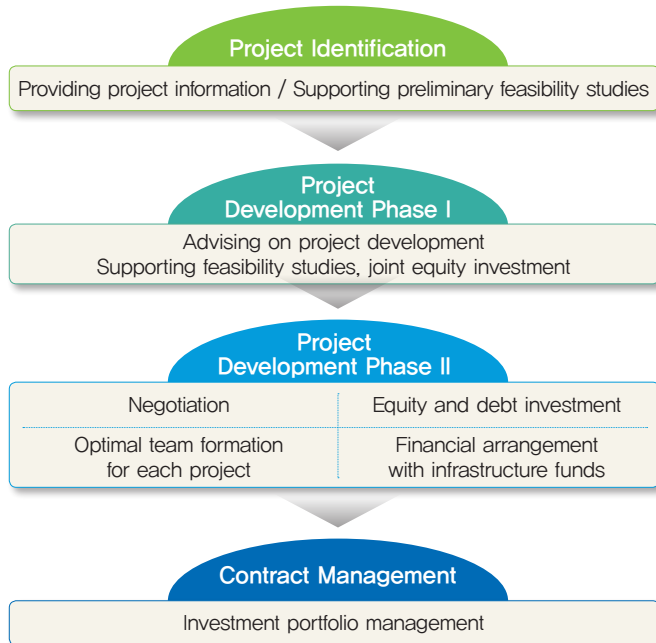

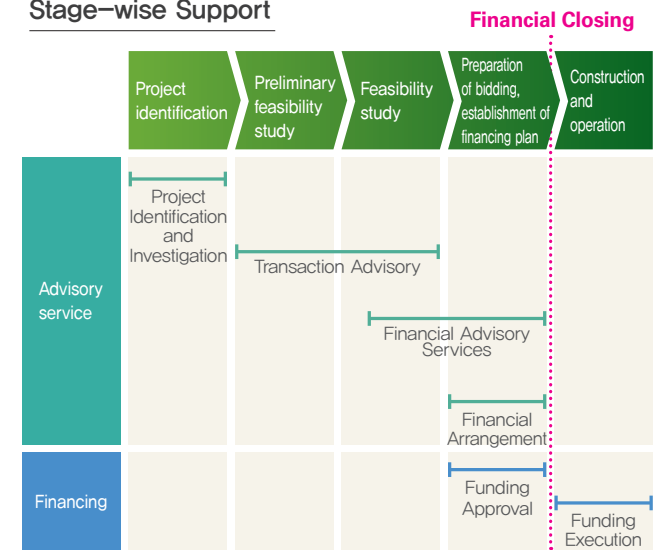
